

Briar Creek Greenway - Arnold Dr. to Masonic Dr.

Paved Greenway = 0.42 Mile



Items of Interest:

What this greenway lacks in length, it more than makes up for in location. The greenway trail provides an important pedestrian linkage between the Merry Oaks and Plaza-Midwood neighborhoods. A pedestrian bridge spans the creek and offers greenway visitors a chance to stop and see turtles burrow in the creek's bottom, count fish as they swim downstream, and watch as a great blue heron stalks its prey.

Briar Creek Greenway will eventually stretch over 6 miles and link to Little Sugar Creek Greenway at Tyvola Road and Methodist Home Park at Eastway Drive.

Briar Creek Greenway Parking

- Traveling East on Central Av, turn Left onto Masonic Dr
- Traveling West on Central Av, turn Right onto Masonic Dr
- Access to Briar Creek Greenway is located approx. 100 yards on the Right. On street parking is available on Masonic Dr.
